ASCA Service Membership and Tracking Number Application

In order to have ASCA trial points tracked and to receive titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type, Service, is required). ASCA membership does not have to be maintained in subsequent years.

It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify previous ASCA points earned when applying for a Tracking Number.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I have to have a tracking number to compete?

- You do not need a tracking number in order to compete in Agility or Stock.
- You will need a tracking number to enter an Obedience trial, Rally trial, or Tracking Test.
- Your dog does not have to be a purebred to receive a tracking number from ASCA.

Why would I need or want a tracking number for my dog?

If you would like to have your dog's points recorded by ASCA, and to receive title certificates in the mail for your accomplishments, you will need to obtain a tracking number.

What is the total cost for a tracking number?


In order to obtain a tracking number for your dog, you must be at least a Service member. The cost for Service Membership is \$10.

 Your membership is good for one year; however, it does not need to be maintained in subsequent years, unless you want to obtain another tracking number for another dog after your membership has expired.


This membership fee is in addition to the tracking fee of \$10 per dog. A tracking number is good for the lifetime of the dog. If you only have one dog, the total cost would be \$20. For two dogs, the cost would be \$30, etc.

PLEASE USE THIS SPACE TO PAY WITH A CREDIT CARD

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- 1. Take geese out of Take Pen & into Goose Arena. Pen work 5pts
- Leave geese at end of arena, call dog off, take dog to cone & gather geese to cone. Adv handler send dog from side. Open handler dog at cone, handler may go halfway. Gather 20pts
- 3. Take geese into alley through gate #1, out gate #2 and back into goose arena through gate #3. Put geese into original pen through Take Pen. Adv handler must stay at gate #1 until geese are at gate #2. Open handler may go anywhere. **Location specific 20 pts**
- 4. Take 1 assigned pen of sheep and put into Take Pen. Take dog out through gate #4 into sheep arena. **Pen work 10 pts.**
- 5. Take sheep from Take Pen into arena, Pen work 5pts
- 6. Take sheep into chute, spray, open gate and exit chute. Adv handler must drive sheep into chute from Adv handlers line. Open handler: may go anywhere along chute. **Chute 20pts**
- 7. Take sheep to and load into trailer/unload and go to Take Pen. Location specific 20pts
- 8. At Take Pen sort 3 sheep into Take Pen. After sort, put remaining sheep into Take Pen. Handler & dog go through gate#4 Adv handlers must sort 3 marked sheep. Open handler must sort 2 marked plus 1 other. **Sort 25**
- 9. Take sheep out of Take Pen and put into original pen. Pen work 5pts



- 1. Take out 1 assigned pen of sheep and put into Take Pen. Take dog out through gate #4 into sheep arena. **Pen work 10 pts.**
- 2. Take sheep from Take Pen into arena, Pen work 5pts
- 3. Take sheep into chute, spray, open gate and exit chute. Adv handler must drive sheep into chute from Adv handlers line. Open may go anywhere along chute. **Chute 20pts**
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
