ENTRIES AND CHANGES – Entries submitted prior to the Opening Date will **not** be accepted. Requests for changes or move-ups to your entry must be received in writing or email to the Trial Secretary by April 1, 2026. Move-ups will be allowed at this trial.

SITE INFORMATION

Interior searches will be held indoors on tile and/or carpeted flooring. Container searches may be on tile or concrete, exterior searches will be held outdoors on concrete and/or gravel, and vehicle searches will be outside on concrete and/or dirt, and may include walking on gravel and uneven surfaces.

Ample parking is available. Competitors will need to crate out of their vehicles. Be sure to bring plenty of shade. There will be no food concessions on site. Several fast-food restaurants are within 10 minutes of the trial site. We will have pre-packaged snacks and water available to everyone who volunteers.

Please clean up after your dog and yourself at the event site. Those not cleaning up will be dismissed from the trial at the discretion of the trial committee.

The event will take place both indoors and outdoors. No indoor crating will be available. The parking area is a regular parking lot. If you are uncertain about the conditions, it is recommended to bring booties for your dog.

There is no shade and there is no water on site so please bring enough for you and your dog(s).

OTHER INFORMATION:

Bitches in season may compete. Bitches will be kenneled in a vehicle and potty in an area away from everyone else. Teams will run last in their class and should also wear a red bandana to remind others to maintain a safe distance. Bitches in season must wear pants while competing. Competitor should contact the trial secretary at least seventy-two (72) hours in advance if they anticipate their dog may be in season to allow for any adjustment in the run schedule and parking/exercise arrangements.

Dogs must have an ASCA registration number, LEP number, or tracking number if competing for titles.

Cancellation Policy: Withdrawal for any reason before entries close will be eligible for a full refund. No refund requests will be issued after the closing date March 27, 2026. No refunds will be issued for absent, disqualified, or excused dogs. No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot be opened or completed for reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Acts of God, or public emergency. After close of pre-entries, refunds will only be given with proof from a veterinarian that a dog is ill, injured, or deceased less a \$20/day processing fee.

These trials will be held under current rules and regulations of ASCA. No entry will be accepted from a handler or dog not in good standing with ASCA. ASCA Registration/ Tracking number is not needed to enter, only needed to track titles.

Spectators and videoing information will be provided during the judge's briefing.

DOG POLICIES

1. All dogs must always be on a 6' leash when not staging or trialing. NO flexi-leashes while not staging or trialing.
2. Dogs will be toileted in designated areas and handlers must pick-up and dispose of waste. Toileting on man-made objects is prohibited.
3. Dogs and handlers must stay in designated areas to avoid contaminating search areas.
4. Handlers should expect to keep their dogs confined in a crate or vehicle when not staging or trialing and should plan to provide their own shade using canopies or shade cloths.
5. Unentered dogs must remain in the handler's vehicle during the event day. There will be ample potty areas, but unentered dogs should not be allowed to "play", exercise, or train on the event grounds.
6. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs, or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

The facility, ASC of AZ, the Trial Chair/Secretary, their agents, officers and/or committee assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to spectators. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs or guests. Any Exhibitor whose dog or guests create an unnecessary disturbance or engage in an unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the direction of the trial committee be asked to leave.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- If your dog is an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd, include your dog's ASCA registration number on the entry form.
- If your dog is not ASCA registered and you would like to earn ASCA titles, you will need to obtain an ASCA tracking number and include it on the entry form.
- ASCA Scent Detection trials are open to all purebred and mixed breed dogs. ASCA registration or a QT number is not required to enter. However, it is necessary to have an ASCA registration or QT number to earn titles. Breeds other than registered Australian Shepherds need a QT number to earn titles. - An ASCA Service Membership and Tracking Number Form is included is available at www.asca.org.
- The postmark (not the delivery date) will determine the entry order. Any Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without recipient signature.
- There will be a \$25.00 service charge for any returned check. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- Confirmations and other communications are sent primarily via e-mail. It is your responsibility to make sure that the secretary's e-mail address of cdxaussie@yahoo.com is allowed by your spam blocker, and to change options that strip attachments from emails.
- Final confirmations will be sent to the e-mail address provided on the entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the confirmation within 7 days of the closing date, contact the Trial Secretary at cdxaussie@yahoo.com.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial is sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of America with the Australian Shepherd Club of Arizona as the sponsoring club.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial including the following:

- All healthy, trained dogs are eligible to compete in ASCA Scent Detection trials.
- Exhibitors should always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion.
- Bitches in Season are allowed to compete. They must be kennelled and potty in an area away from others, wear pants and run last, and the competitor should contact the trial secretary seventy-two hours in advance if they anticipate their dog will be in season.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside or outside the search areas, must be excused from the Scent Detection trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in sufficient control to perform all the searches in a safe manner will be excused from the Scent Detection trial.
- Exhibitors agree that if their dog(s) is (are) left unattended, they will be secured in a crate or x-pen. Owner/handlers whose dogs are tethered or improperly secured will not be allowed on the show grounds.
- No tents, crates or other aids or devices shall be permitted within 20' of the search area.
- All dogs shall be on leash when not competing.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- The sponsoring club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result is accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.
- The organizing committee may not refuse any entry other than on the basis expressly provided through rules and regulations of the sanctioning organization. Anyone not currently in good standing with ASCA will not be allowed to enter the trial.
- No alcoholic beverages or illicit substances are permitted on the grounds at an ASC of AZ event. Violators will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law and barred from entry as a spectator or participant at future ASC of AZ events.
- NO SMOKING allowed on the trial grounds.
- Poor sportsmanship will **NOT** be tolerated. If anyone exhibits poor sportsmanship (i.e., yells at, curses at, harasses, etc.) any volunteer or competitor, he/she will forfeit their entries for the rest of the show weekend, and will be asked to immediately leave the show grounds and any incidents will be reported to ASCA.

The Management will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for possessions of any exhibitor whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time dog is on the premises.

EXHIBITOR/OWNER OR PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN (IF JR IS UNDER 18) MUST READ AND SIGN THIS FORM

AGREEMENT

IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT—Please read the following carefully as it, among other things, may prevent you from suing ASCA® and persons/entities affiliated with it. This agreement could even require you to defend them from demands and suits by third parties that include an assertion of wrongdoing by you. (1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s)/exhibitor(s)/handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as "Applicant"). (2) "Releasees" here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its affiliate clubs; and the officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents of ASCA® and of those clubs. (3) This Agreement voluntarily is entered into by Applicant in exchange for the acceptance of the associated entry form and permission to participate in related activities. (4) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations applicable to this event. (5) Applicant certifies that the entered dog will not pose a hazard to people, property, stock animals, or other dogs, and further that the dog is current with rabies shots along with any other vaccinations required by its state of residence. (6) Applicant acknowledges and assumes the risks to Applicant and Applicant's dog associated with participation in the event, among which could be ones associated with poor condition of the facilities and surrounding areas; security measures or lack of them; electrical appliances; fittings; show rings; the presence of unfamiliar persons; and the presence/involvement of other animals—whether stock, dogs, or otherwise. (7) Applicant further agrees to comply with all recommended and required health and safety precautions, among which may be those related to social distancing; quarantining; wearing of face coverings; and non-participation of persons exhibiting symptoms or for whom there otherwise has been a likelihood of recent exposure to COVID-19 or other contagious diseases. (8) Applicant additionally acknowledges and agrees to assume the risks associated with taking part in the event though others might neglect compliance with health and safety precautions/requirements or pose an undue risk of spreading disease. For example, as is true as to any public event, there is some risk that Applicant and/or those affiliated with Applicant may catch COVID-19 or another contagious disease at the event. (9) To the maximum extent permissible, this release is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice of law rules. (10) To the extent that Applicant—or another party suing on behalf of Applicant, or suing to recover based on injuries/death/damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property—sues ASCA® (or a board member or staff member or agent of ASCA®) as a defendant, the sole appropriate forum (to the maximum extent permitted by law) for the suit shall be the state or federal courts serving Brazos County, Texas (where ASCA® has its headquarters). (11) Applicant hereby releases and waives any claims Applicant otherwise might assert against the Releasees as to any injury or damage claim connected in any way to any alleged act or omission arising out of, or occurring concurrent with, the event and related activities, interactions, communications, and even adjacent premises. (12) This release is made not only as to Applicant but also for anyone who might assert a claim on behalf of Applicant or based on purported injury or damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property, as well as any heir, beneficiary, assignee, executor, trustee, agent, or survivor of Applicant. (13) Applicant further agrees to assume sole responsibility for and indemnify and hold Releasees harmless from related claims, demands, judgments, and settlement payments. (14) These waiver, release, and indemnification provisions extend even to claims or demands asserting that the acts or omissions resulted in bodily injury or death or from intentional wrongdoing, as well as to attorney fees and other costs of defense. (15) The duties of indemnification further extend to any claims or demands asserted against Releasees that are alleged to have arisen out of the acts or omissions of Applicant, Applicant's dog, or others affiliated with Applicant. Among other things, this means that Applicant would pay the legal defense of Releasees if someone sued them based on a claim Applicant carelessly exposed the claimant to COVID-19. (16) Applicant's promises in this agreement apply without regard to the type of claim or cause of action asserted against Releasees. (17) To the extent any provision of this agreement is unenforceable, the remainder of it nonetheless is to be enforced. (18) This agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releasees with the maximum permissible legal protection from—among other things—claims and suits pursued by Applicant (and/or those acting on behalf of Applicant or over injury/damage to Applicant), as well as from ones based on the purported wrongful acts or omissions of Applicant. (19) Nothing in this Agreement requires you to indemnify Releasees from claims by third parties that involve no allegations of improper acts or omissions by you, those affiliated with you, nor your dog(s). (20) Applicant acknowledges having read, understood, and had the opportunity for independent legal review of this document prior to signing it.
